Lumbering and Shingle Concerns File Articles of Incorporation.

Today articles of incorporation of the Drain Lumber Co, the Roseburg Lumber Co and the Pacific Cedar and Shingle Co filed articles of incorporation with County Clerk E U Lee, the same articles having been previously filed with Secretary of State F I Dunbar.

The incorporation of each of these companies are Geo Kerr, W C Johnson and F M Eby, all substantial citizens of Cottage Grove, and the principal office and place of business is given as Cottage Grove. The capital stock of each company is \$25,000, divided into 250 shares of \$100 each.

The objects of each company, as given in the articles of incorporation are identically the same, in substance as follows: To manufacture, sell, buy and deal in all kinds of building material; to have power to buy land; to lease, operate and build plants for the manufacture of building material; engage in the general merchandise business, etc.

It is understood that this company, or companies, will engage in the lumber and shingle business on quite an extensive scale in Lane and Douglas counties, no doubt to erect mills at Roseburg, Drain and other points. It is also said their operations will extend to the coast, probably to Coos Bay or Gardiner and along the line of the proposed Great Central railway.
