

THE PRESIDENT ON TRIAL.

There is no doubt that many republicans and some democrats have confidence that the president intends to destroy the trusts and events will show whether their faith is well grounded. The Commoner has pointed out, first, that he has not enforced existing laws, and, second, that he always speaks of regulating bad trusts, not of destroying all trusts. It has denied and still denies that the president is planning to attack the principle of private monopoly, but the republican party has been sustained at the polls and the president must fight the trusts (and be fought by them) or disappoint the hopes which most of his supporters entertain. It must be remembered that some of the republicans leaders have been defending the trusts as a necessary step in economic development and these will gravely inform the president that the voters have indorsed his inaction and that he must not risk the effect of a vigorous attack on the great monopolies.

The president has the responsibility which comes with power, and is on trial before the people. Having called attention to the trust question himself he cannot ignore it when congress meets. Many will judge him by the manner in which he meets the issue.
