

Y. P. S. C. E. Movement.

Rev Francis E. Clark, the founder of the Christian Endeavor movement, is sending circulars to the state officers asking them to take part in a great forward movement for 1903. An effort is to be made to increase the number of societies in the state by ten per cent, and to add ten per cent, to the roll of each society. The state making the required increase will be presented with a banner at the International Convention in Denver, and the successful societies will be placed on the roll of honor.

There are no restrictions: Members may be active associate or honorary; and the societies, senior, intermediate or junior. Each district will be assigned its share of the work.

With a definite object, a ten per cent increase, and a definite time, from January first to the Denver Convention in June, Oregon will doubtless claim a banner for state work, and many societies be on the roll of honor.

A Report on Soldier's Home.

The committee appointed to investigate and report on the condition of the Oregon Soldier's Home submitted a report Wednesday. Home is reported in exemplary condition, and without precedent. Committee recommended appropriations for the institution as follows: Maintenance, \$12,000, new barracks, \$4000 hospital \$2500; minor improvements \$1500; laundry, \$2600; furniture \$500; new sidewalks, \$500.

The House has voted by 38 yeas to repeal the scalp bounty graft, which has already cost the State about \$360,000 with no benefit to anything except the coyotes that have rapidly increased under its fostering care.

Hereafter all capital punishments will be inflicted within the walls of the penitentiary at Salem. Both houses of the legislature have passed the bill for this purpose and it will undoubtedly receive the approval of the governor.

Dispatches show the limits of the storm to be Nevada in the West, the Atlantic ocean in the East the Great Lakes in the North, Texas and Georgia in the South.

To Give The Tracy Merrill Victims \$1000 Each.

The committee on resolutions Wednesday reported favorably on H C R 3, by Judd directing the ways and means committee to assert in the appropriation bill an allowance of \$1000 each for the relief of the widows of the three guards who were murdered at the state prison outbreak last June. By a vote of 25 to 12 the resolution was adopted.

An unusual bill, by Kuykendall yet one which is in force in some states of the Union, has been passed by the legislature. It provides for district school boards to furnish transportation to pupils living more than two miles from the school building, when such decision shall be made by a majority vote at any legally called school meeting. When it may be done at lesser expense the board may pay the board of pupils instead of furnishing conveyance. The expense is to be met when necessary by a special levy.
