Disasterous Freight Wreck.

Quite a disasterous freight wreck occurred near the Alca siding in Pass Creek Canyon six miles south of this city last Saturday evening. The freight was south bound and just as it was nearing the rugged point designated above, a sill 16x16 inch and 16 feet in length slipped from a flat car and dropped down endwise to the track between the flat and box car. The train was running at the usual rate of speed and as the end of the heavy timber dragged on the ties between the cars the track was torn up for quite a distance and finally both cars were derailed. Both trucks were torn from under the box car and hurled down the embankment while the car loaded with lathes toppled over the grade and landed bottom side up against a telegraph pole. The fore trucks of the flat car were torn out and the car which was loaded with lumber toppled over scattering the lumber down the grade. Several rails were bent and broken and many ties torn up. The wrecking train arrived from Roseburg about midnight and the track was cleared by eight o'clock Sunday morning. Fortunately no one was injured, and it seems the accident resulted wholly from undue carelessness in loading and securing the heavy timbers on the flat car.

Notice to Tax Payers.

The 1902 assessment Rolls for Lane County, Oregon, will be opened for the collection of taxes on Monday March 2nd, 1903. There will be a 3 per cent rebate given on all taxes paid in full previous to March 15th. One half of any tax may be paid at any date before April 6th and if so paid the remaining one half may be paid any date before October 5th, without penalty or interest. In case a tax or the first one half is not paid before April 6th the law requires a 10 per cent penalty and 12 per cent interest to be added to such tax until paid.
