The longest line of fence in the world will be the wire fence extending from Indian Territory west across the Texas Panhandle, and thirty-five miles into New Mexico. We are informed that eighty-five miles of this fence is already under contract. Its course will be in the line of the Canadian river, and its purpose is to stop the drift of the northern cattle. It is a bold splendid enterprise and will pay a large percentage on the investment. The fence will be over two hundred miles long.


