While the subject of plagiarism is again being widely discussed, we are moved to suggest this very appropriate text for an original sermon by every minister addicted to this sin: "Thou that preachest a man should not steal, dost thou steal?" (Rom. ii. 21') And at the close of the sermon this spiritual response should be made by all the people; "Let him that stole steal no more" (Eph. iv. 28)—Baptist Weekly.
