Wolves suffer heartbreak again

Women's basketball falls by one against Saint Martin's

LACEY, Wash. — It was heartbreak again for Western Oregon's women's basketball team as the Wolves fell 48-47 to Saint Martin's on Saturday.

Dana Goularte scored a team-high 10 points as WOU held a 44-40 lead with 3:56 remaining in the game.

The Saints, however, scored eight unanswered points to take a 48-44 lead with six seconds left. Elise Miller hit a 3-pointer for the Wolves' final points.

"We got on the glass, gave ourselves second opportu-

nities and put ourselves in position to win, but made some costly mistakes down the stretch," Western Oregon coach Holli Howard-Carpenter said.

WOU plays at Alaska Fairbanks on Thursday and Alaska Anchorage on Saturday.

BASEBALL OPENS SEASON: Western Oregon's baseball team opened its 2015 campaign with a trio of losses against the University of California-San Diego on Sunday and Monday. The Tritons won a doubleheader 4-0, and 8-3 on Sunday. Pitchers Darrien Moran and Clark McKittrick took the losses for the Wolves. Senior Matt Taylor went 2 for 4 with 2 RBIs during the second game. The Tritons defeated WOU 12-5 on Monday. The Wolves closed out their four-game series with the Tritons

Tuesday after press time. WOU plays a four-game set at Point Loma Nazarene Thursday through Saturday.

WOLVES SET PERSONAL MARKS: Freshman Cody Warner ran an NCAA Division II provisional qualifying time Saturday at the Husky Invite in Seattle. Warner finished the 60-meter run in 6.89 seconds, missing qualifying for the finals by .03 seconds. Senior Brady Beagley set a personal record in the 1,600-meter run (4:11.20), while sophomore Rachel Crawford set a personal record in the mile (5:12.94). Senior Rebecca Laible set a new personal mark in the

triple jump (35 feet, 10 3/4 inches) and junior Emmi Collier set a personal record in the shot put (43-3 3/4). WOU will compete at the Cougar Indoor meet Friday and Saturday in Pullman, Wash.

Western Oregon's softball team begins its 2015 season Friday at the Tucson, Ariz. Lead-Off Classic.

The Wolves finished 34-23 overall in 2014 and 18-6 in Great Northwest Athletic Conference play, winning the conference regular season and tournament title.

WOU was picked as the co-favorite with Central Washington in the GNAC preseason poll.
