 "I like the attitude already," Schwartz said. "Three or four of the underclassmen asked if the junior varsity coach was going to open the gym on Sunday so they could work on their game. We will be a different

team next year. We won't have the length that we've had and won't be as post oriented. It will be fun to see the younger kids coming up."
 While the Dragons failed to reach the quarterfinals, Dallas reached the state's

final 16 teams for the first time since the 1999-2000 season, Schwartz said, an accomplishment that the players should be proud of.
 And Schwartz hopes the team will build off of this season's success in the com-

ing years.
 "They accomplished what no other Dallas boys team had done in the past 15 years," Schwartz said. "They worked their tails off and they were driven. To see the players mature was rewarding."
