Upstairs, reachable via a small lift for those unable to make the climb, was a workout space, washer and dryer, and locker rooms for showering.

"It is my personal belief that this is one of those jobs that people have to be fit for duty," Haines said. "We didn't have a place for officers to do that."

Now, regardless of an officer's odd schedule, he or she will have access to fitness equipment before or after a shift, Haines

The washer and dryer will help keep uniforms contaminated with bodily fluids away from officers' families.

It was the "little things" that added up to big ones. "Little things make us excited because we haven't had them,"

Delphine Freshower commented that they

thought of everything, including a floor "toilet" to help clean up after prisoners who may vomit or have an accident in the temporary holding cells or in the booking

Haines said.

Overall, she said the new building is great for the public.

"It's lovely," she said. "It's well thoughtout. A lot of time and effort went into it."



The building was made possible by a bond approved by voters in May 2013. The total costs of the building ran over the \$4 million bond, totaling about \$4.5 million, said City Manager Scott McClure.

The new police station was a remodel project, using the exisiting former Boise Cascade structure. Because of the way that building was designed, some office spaces had to be modified from the traditional box model. The office for the sergeants, for example, has a slight L shape because of exisitging beams.

Tallan said the building will provide proper room for the current police personnel, as well as into the future.

"This building will serve the citizens of Monmouth for a very long time, and it's something we should all be proud of," he

Two Dallas High students receive DVFA scholarships


DALLAS — The Dallas Volunteer Firefighters Association has awarded the Harpy Bovard Scholarship to two Dallas High School seniors.
