Remember when? **Key Moments In History**

Kindergarten — MySpace founded, August 2003. First grade — Facebook founded, January 2004. Open to anyone in 2006.

Second grade — Hurricane Katrina devastates the South, 2005. Third grade — Twitter founded, March 2006.

Fourth grade — First iPhone released June 2007.

Fifth grade — February 2008 Fidel Castro resigns as president of Cuba.

Sixth grade — January 2009 Pres. Barack Obama was sworn in as the 44th president, the first ican-American to be elected president.

Seventh grade — Haiti suffers a massive 7.0 earthquake.

Eighth grade — Osama bin Laden was killed by Navy Seals in May 2011. **Ninth grade** — Steve Jobs, the creator of the iPhone and Apple, died in October 2011.

10th grade — A 2-year-old girl born with HIV is cured from the disease in March 2013.

11th grade — Demonstrations occur across Egypt with 15 million people calling for the resignaon of their President, Mohammed Morsi.

12th grade — November 2014 brought riots in Ferguson, Mo., after an officer-involved shooting. In 2003, while these seniors were wrapping up kindergarten and moving into first grade: Music Billboard top song — "In da Club," 50 Cent; Best Picture — The Lord of the Rings: Return of the King; Highest grossing picture: Return of the King, \$377.02 million (Box Office Mojo).

In 2014, wrapping up their junior year and beginning their senior year: Music Billboard top song — "Happy," Pharrell Williams; Best Picture — Birdman; Highest grossing picture: American Sniper, \$350.09 million.
