Pirates extend win streak to five

PERRYDALE — Perrydale's girls basketball team defeated Falls City, Southwest Christian and St. John Bosco last week to improve to 8-5 overall and 6-1 in Casco League play.

The Pirates defeated the Mountaineers 30-25 on Jan. 5 and Southwest Christian 45-24 on Thursday before downing St. John Bosco 43-30 on Friday.
