Wales art will be on display at the Dallas Public Library, 950 Main St., Dallas.

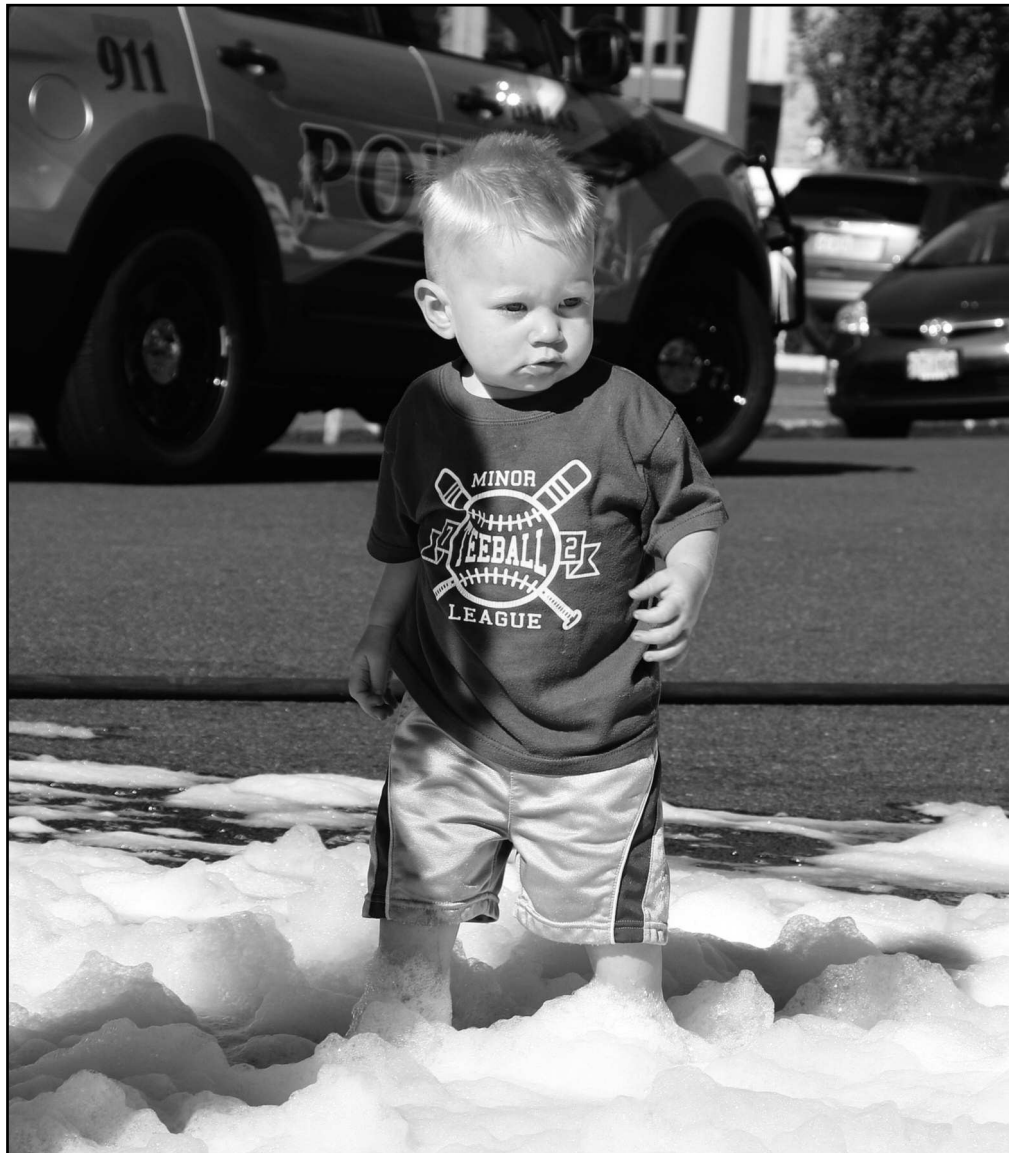
