Participants should bring a sack lunch. Beverages and snacks will be provided at the event.

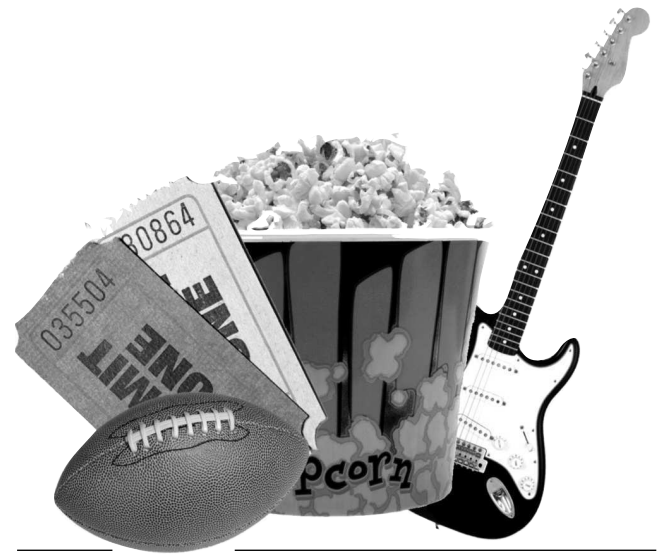
