The Corvallis Times, usually a careful and reliable newspaper, attempted last week to explain why the receipts of the Corvallis carnival were \$2000 less than those of the Dallas carnival, and in doing so, strayed from the path of truth and veracity. The Times says: "The entire receipts of the shows are said to be in the neighborhood of \$3,000, of which the Woodmen are to have 10 per cent. The receipts of the first day's performance was \$450, but each day thereafter the revenue increased. At Dallas the Woodmen cleared about \$800 out of the carnival. There the skin games, not permitted to operate in Corvallis, were allowed to run, and the Woodmen collected \$10 a day, from each of them. The total receipts of the Arnold shows at Dallas were about \$5,000."

The truth is that no gambling games of any kind were permitted to operate at the Dallas carnival. If the editor of the Times would only stop and think twice, he would remember that a great fraternal order like the Woodmen of the World does not raise needed funds by taking a "take-off" from skin games. The Woodman boys are not engaged in that kind of business. The Woodman carnival in Dallas was a great financial success, notwithstanding the fact that Dallas is the smallest city in Oregon in which a carnival and street

fair has ever been held. It was a success because it was well advertised. People came here from all parts of Western Oregon, and Polk county turned out almost to a man. The people in and around Dallas are prosperous. They had money to spend, and they spent it. Mr. Arnold's tents were crowded at every performance, and of the immense admittance receipts the Woodmen received 10 per cent. Mr. Arnold made money and so did the Woodmen—and none of it came from skin games. The Dallas carnival was advertised; the Corvallis carnival was not. Dallas people spent their money liberally; Corvallis people did not. According to the Times' own figures, the receipts at Dallas were \$5000, and at Corvallis \$3000. The only conclusion to be drawn is that Dallas is a better town than Corvallis in the proportion of 5 to 3. The Times' figures prove it.

The Sutor Lumber Company are driving the foundation for their new mill at Linnton, a few miles below Portland. The company has ten acres of land. The mill machinery will be equipped by the Allis Company, with the exception of the power, which is furnished by J. M. Arthur & Company, and consists of a 22x28 Tangee, Erie City engine and two boilers 18x72, which are estimated to develop 350 horse-power. The mill building will be 36x200 feet, with a planer shed 36x200 feet. The company have 800 feet of water front, with 34 feet of water. The company consists of R. D.
