Sealed proposals will be received at the office of the Auditor and Police Judge of the City of Dallas, Oregon, until May 21, 1904, at one o'clock p. m. for the construction of a sewer in Court Street from Hayter street to the County road at the East end of Court street; a sewer in Mill Street from Hayter street East to Lytle street and South on Lytle street to intersect the above-mentioned sewer on Court street; and an outlet sewer from the East end of the above-mentioned Court street sewer at the County road, Northwesterly to the 'L' Canal River.
