

## WILL TREAT COPPER ORE

Large Number of Dallas People Interested in Development of Freeland Mines.

The Freeland Consolidated Mining Company is preparing to make a forward movement that will likely mean a great deal to the Santiam mining district. It is the intention of the company to go to work at once and put in a plant for the leaching process. It is the purpose to complete this plant in time to get it running this season.

One of the moving spirits in this latest undertaking is F. H. Colpitts, a practical mining engineer, who has become interested with the company, and who has been in Colorado for a year. It is proposed to make the plant a small one to begin with, having a capacity of ten tons a day, but which may be readily increased in size. As the ore in sight will run about \$15 worth of copper, \$2 worth of gold and some silver to the ton, it is easy to see that even a ten-ton plant will make a considerable industry; and as the plant can be operated for about \$30 a day, it will prove a paying mine.

R. C. Craven, the Dallas banker, is president of the Freeland company, and there are a large number of Dallas people owning stock. Most of them have seen the mine, and are enthusiastic over the prospects of making a big thing out of it in the course of time.

J. L. Freeland, of Salem, is secretary and treasurer; Hugh Freeland, his brother, superintendent; and J. E. Sibley, of Dallas, is secretary.

The Freeland mine consists of ten claims, on Gold creek, a tributary to the Little North Fork of the Santiam, about eighteen miles from Gates, on the Corvallis & Eastern railroad. Two tunnels have already been run into the side of the mountain, and there is a vast amount of ore in sight.

If this leaching plant, which is now proposed for the approaching season, proves a success, as it is confidently expected, it will open the way for the further development of that district, which will one day pour millions of wealth into the lap of the Willamette valley.—Salem Statesman.
