BRISK FIRE IN DRYER

Blaze in Kimball Prune Evaporator Quickly Subdued by Fire Department.

The S. P. Kimball prune dryer caught fire Sunday afternoon, and serious loss was prevented only by the prompt and efficient work of the fire department. The blaze was in the lower end of the three outside tunnels in the older part of the drier, and it was a difficult matter to reach it. A hose crew, however, was stationed at each end of the three tunnels, and, opening the slides, they poured in two streams of water that literally drowned out the flames. The damage was comparatively small, consisting chiefly of the loss of the fruit which was in the three tunnels at the time the fire broke out.

Prompt work was done in repairing the damage, and the dryer was again in operation by Sunday midnight. The drying of the remainder of the crop will not be seriously hampered, as it will be possible to finish the work with the tunnels that were not damaged. Mr. Kimball is very grateful to the firemen for their prompt and efficient work. Only a few years ago, when Dallas had no adequate water supply, he lost one dryer by fire, and he has no desire for a repetition of the experience.
