Hop Growers Will Meet.

For the purpose of furthering the work of organization of the Pacific Hop Growers' Union in Polk County, a meeting of the county association has been called at Dallas for Saturday, at 1 o'clock p. m. The session will be presided over by Hon. I. M. Simpson, of Monmouth, president of the association, and director of this district for the Pacific Coast Union. Many prominent hop growers and buyers will be present from Polk and adjoining counties, and the program of the afternoon will doubtless be of interest not only to hop men, but also to those who are interested in building up Oregon and her industries.
