**ONE KIND OF POLITICS.**  
 We sometimes wonder just how many so-called Governor Chamberlains there are in Oregon. We certainly have a right to think there are a good many, especially in the Republican party, but we sometimes wonder if he doesn't overestimate the number. Just now the Governor is going over the state and making campaign speeches in which he bewails the attack made on Senator Fulton by Francis J. Heney. This is nothing but a cheap attempt to win votes among Mr. Fulton's personal friends and political supporters. Wonder if the Governor thinks the people of Oregon have forgotten Mr. Heney's first speech in Portland, in which the California prosecutor gave the Governor as his authority for quoting what was supposed to have been said in an interview between Fulton and Chamberlain concerning the appointment of one J. B. Smith to a position in the penitentiary—an interview, by the way, which Senator Fulton says was not at all as quoted by Mr. Heney, and one which he thought was to have been kept secret as confidential between himself and the Governor. It will be remembered that Heney was using this interview in an attempt to injure Fulton's candidacy, and it will also be remembered that the Governor rushed into print the next morning to confirm all that Heney had said. This, of course, all happened at a time when Chamberlain was expecting to have Fulton as his opponent at the June election instead of Mr. C. Heney, and he was not particularly concerned about defending Fulton's character against Heney's attacks just then; in fact, he showed an eager willingness to assist the Heney game as far as possible by jumping into print and confirming all that had been said about the Smith interview.

Now, with Mr. Fulton out of the way, the Governor makes a cheap bid for Fulton votes by saying that Mr. C. Heney should have defended the Senator from the attacks of Heney. It was noticeable that the Governor did not do any defending as long as Fulton was in the race, but was helping Heney all he could. The contest between C. Heney and Fulton was absolutely clean and free from personalities, each pledging the victorious candidate his support in the event of his own defeat. The only help Heney got was from the Democratic candidate. The efforts being put forth by Senator Fulton to elect Mr. C. Heney prove that Fulton is sincere in his desire for a Republican victory, and it also proves that in attempting to stir up bitterness where there is none, Oregon's governor is exhibiting many of the qualities of a political shyster.

One of the good things to vote in favor of is the armory bill which comes up for consideration at this election. Don't vote it down. Remember that we have a militia company at Dallas and they will be benefited by that bill.—Independence West Side.

Real estate agents in Dallas report a marked increase in the demand and sale of property in and about the city during the past month. They predict a busy summer, and a goodly addition to the population of Polk County by immigration from the Eastern states.
