Reports from the orchards of the Salem district indicate that the August drop of Italian prunes has been more extensive and serious this year than ever before and it is predicted that the yield of this variety of prune in the Willamette valley this year will be about one-half of the amount estimated a month ago. This means that the demand for this excellent class of evaporated fruit will be greatly increased with the advance of the season. In the opinion of old and experienced prune growers, and that the market quotations of the past and present will be, consequently, advanced.
