The Santa Fe trail had its beginning in 1807, through the efforts of American traders to reach the city of Santa Fe by the overland route. Six hundred miles of plains, or the "Great American Desert," as it was called, was the barrier that prevented the Missouri River merchant from extending his trade to the vast Mexican territory, whose commercial center was the old city of Santa Fe.

It is probably the most interesting to me because it marks a scene of activity within the memory of men now living, and being of comparatively recent construction, its age is more easily comprehended and appreciated by one who has made little study of the antiquities.

The Mexican War broke out in 1846, and for a time the Mexicans and Texas freebooters marked the history of the trail with robbery and murder. In that year, the American army of invasion moved over the trail into New Mexico, and in 1848 the vast territory passed into the hands of the United States. In the first eight months of the last named year, 3000 wagons, 30,000 head of live stock and 12,000 persons passed over the trail—all going westward.

Such, in brief, is the early history of the Santa Fe trail—the most remarkable highway our country has ever known. Following the ox wagons came the stage coach and the overland mail, and in 1870 work was commenced on the Atchison, Topeka & Santa Fe railroad. As this road progressed westward, the old trail receded before it, and with its completion, the old highway passed into history. Its work as a commercial and colonizing factor is now being carried on by one of the most extensive and successfully conducted railway systems in the United States.
