UNINJURED BY FEARFUL FALL

Eight-Year-Old Lad Has Miraculous Escape From Severe Injuries.

A slight cut on the top of his head and several severe bruises is all that Custer Rust, the 8-year-old son of Mr. and Mrs. R. H. Rust, has to show for a fall of nearly 30 feet from the second story of Wyatt's store in Black Rock, Saturday night.

The boy was standing by one of the windows watching the dance given in the hall over the store. Suddenly, in some unaccountable way, he lost his balance and pitched backward out of the window, a sheer drop of between 25 and 30 feet with nothing to check his descent or break the force of his fall.

He was picked up, stunned by the fall and bleeding from the cut on his head but apparently only slightly injured. Dr. Starbuck was summoned from Dallas to attend him but was unable to reach Black Rock until Sunday morning. When he arrived, the lad was apparently suffering little inconvenience from the results of his startling adventure.

Will Hold Matinees Daily.

The Electric Palace and The Vaudeville will give matinees during alternate weeks in future, the programs to begin at 2:30 every afternoon and the performance to be continuous until 5 o'clock. The matinees are held for the benefit of those who are unable to come out to the evening entertainments and to people who may come in from the country. During the present week the matinees will be given at the Electric Palace under the management of Whiteside & Brown and next week they will be at the Vaudeville. Admission for children to the matinees will be reduced from 10 to 5 cents for all under 15 years of age. The afternoon entertainments will be continued in this manner throughout the winter. The evening shows will be run independently at both theaters, the regular admission price being charged.

Rickreall Store Robbed.

The store of Peter Cook in Rickreall, was entered by burglars last night and about \$75 worth of knives, razors and other small goods was stolen. The postoffice was also broken open but the burglars secured only a few dollars, worth of stamps. The proprietor of the store has secured no clue as yet to the identity of the men who committed the crime, but suspicion points to three hoboes who were seen loitering about the town on the night the robbery was committed.

Council Appoints Night Watch.

W. W. Dawson was appointed night watchman for the city of Dallas at the regular meeting of the city council last night with a salary of \$60 a month. Of this sum \$51.75 has been subscribed by the business men of Dallas and the remainder, \$8.25, has been granted from the city's funds. Mr. Dawson will assume his duties at once.

The big cellar under Adams & Brobst's furniture store in the Riley building is now practically completed and the work has been discontinued until the sewer main on Washington street has been completed so that drainage connections can be made with it. The cellar is 2500 feet and is about 7 feet deep. The earth that was taken out in the work of excavation has been distributed over Mr. Riley's lot on the corner of Washington and Jefferson streets, raising it to a grade a trifle higher than that of the street.
