FILE IMPORTANT REPORTS

Cost of Street Improvement and Rebates to Property Owners Submitted to Council.

An adjourned meeting of the city council has been called for Thursday evening, November 5, and, at that meeting, the various claims against the city, which were passed over at last night's session, will be read and passed upon.

Two important reports were filed at the meeting last night, one giving an itemized account by blocks, of the actual cost of the macadam work on the streets, and the other giving a full list of the names of those property holders who are entitled to a rebate on the sums collected for the payment of the expenses of the improvement work.

The cost of the street building, not including extra excavation or curb irons ordered by property holders, is as follows:

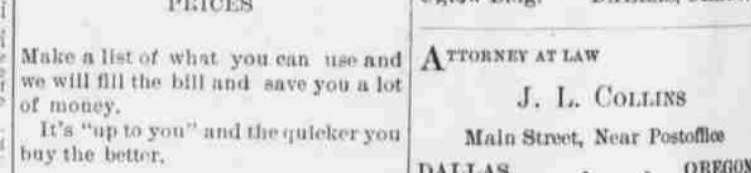
