Remedy For Cowpox.
Oxide of zinc ointment rubbed on the cow's legs morning and night is a very good remedy for cowpox. The disease is carried from cow to cow on the hands of the milker, so when the disease is in the herd milkers should wash their hands carefully after milking each cow. Do not use the milk from affected cows until they are cured.

Bovine Tuberculosis.
My experience and observations during the past seven years convince me that bovine tuberculosis is a stable disease, that it is very rarely, if ever, communicated from one animal to another while cows are in the pasture unless it be to a suckling calf, and that it is safe to assert that disease will never be permanently removed from dairy herds until more sanitary conditions are introduced into a great majority of the stables where the dairy cow is housed.—Dr. Leonard Pearson, State Veterinarian.
