WHITE FACED BLACK SPANISH.
 This bird is a native of the country of Alfonso and from there distributed to other lands.
 The Netherlands produces the finest in Europe today, but in the United States the fowls are few.
 Back in the early sixties it was pop-

 ular, and many were bred, especially in New Jersey, Pennsylvania and Ohio.
 Today nearly all Spanish on the continent, and not many at that, are raised in New York, Massachusetts and Canada.
 Reading the old poultry journals of the seventies—Poultry Bulletin, Poultry World, Fancier's Journal and the American Poultry Year—we find eloquent descriptions of "this noble bird," and their advertising columns are full of Black Spanish space.
 Today it is seldom mentioned in the journals.
 In 1870 there was a great display of White Faced Black and White Faced White Spanish at the Centennial exposition.
 Today there are few at the shows, the largest exhibits being found at Boston, the nearest show to the majority of the breeders.
 The White Faced White Spanish has entirely disappeared.
 With the fathers this fowl was especially valuable for its utility.
 They valued its peculiar appearance and show points, but they bred it up to ten pounds for its delicious white flesh and fat and also bred hens that

laid up to the 250 egg mark, and there is no hen that lays a larger, handsomer white shelled egg.
 Today the fowl is classed as "exhibition."
 Among its points that particularly attract fanciers are the long white face, pendulous wattles, large ear lobes, large five point comb, glossy black plumage and expanded tail. Then it is a stately, graceful bird, and its individuality makes it conspicuous.
 "Why has this breed fallen back?"
 Well, it's that same objection again—black pinfeathers, blue legs and white or pink flesh.
 The majority object to these, and the majority rule.
 If you have an open front house it will not improve your temper to find two feet of snow drifted over the litter some zero weather morn. And when it rains on that mushy curtain and the thing freezes hard as a board and cuts off light and air or the icy weight breaks the curtain off and the blast hits your fowls in the neck you will not be in a fit frame of mind to lead a prayer meeting. Old boy, study your location, climate and your plant plan together and make them match.

TUBERCULOSIS AMONG POULTRY.
 A lady's parrot had "warts" and "ulcers" on its toes. She was surprised when we called these tubercles and diagnosed the disease as tuberculosis, commonly called consumption.
 She was terrified when told that the germs of parrot and human tuberculosis are pronounced identical and parrots have died from the bacilli of human sputum, just as the same awful plague has been introduced into a home by the germ laden dust from a parrot's cage.
 Fair lady, does your caroling canary kiss your lips? Be warned. Bird kisses are often fatal as human, for most of the captive birds die of this disease.
 As the late world's tuberculosis convention at Philadelphia differed in re-

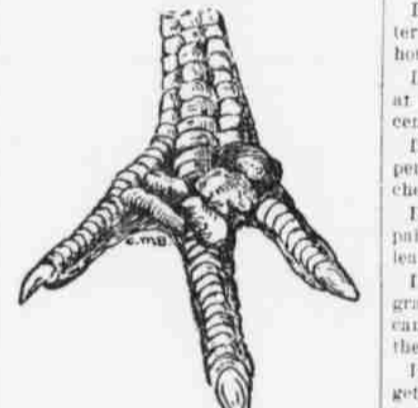
gards 180 to 200 each and the American 175 to 200 and the Mediterranean 180 to 200 eggs per year, and a government report declares the farm hen lays but sixty eggs per annum.
 An informant states that breeding from trap nest females has produced a Brahman that laid 232 eggs, a White Wyandotte pullet that laid 242 and a S. C. White Leghorn hen that laid 251 eggs per year.
 But trap nests are expensive for a big flock, and it is time and trouble to watch them and untrap the birds.
 Now, we believe there is a laying type of hen just as there is a milk type of cow or a ham type of pig.
 We have studied some of our best layers in Leghorns and Wyandottes and hereby give you the principles we use in selecting layers and breeders. They will improve your flock and save you killing your layers for dinner, but in this, as in everything else, you will find exceptions.
 A primer layer must have a well developed, rummy body, so that the organs of respiration, digestion, reproduction, circulation, urination, etc., may properly perform their functions.
 She must breathe well, eat well, digest well, assimilate well, scratch well, be well and have a big bunch of embryo eggs to lay well.
 A hen with rattling, rattling breath is useless.
 A typical layer is plump; she is muscular all her cavities are covered with meat.
 She has simply fat for fuel and weighs heavier for her size than the drone whose feet produces a gob of fat at the end of her breastbone.
 That drone lays the eggs in spring that hatch the drone pullets.
 Follow this table of points for selection:
 Head, medium size; eye, bright, full, open; comb and wattles, medium size, clear color; neck, medium length, stout, well arched; back medium length, broad at shoulders; nice cushiony tail, medium size, angular; buff, good size; body, medium length and depth, with medium underline and good legs; breast, broad, round, full; legs, stout, short between feet and shanks; feet, set square and wide apart.
 Hens of this style fed a proper variety of food will keep you busy hatching eggs to market.
 Mated to a male of egg laying strain such hens will furnish fertile eggs to hatch pullets that will sunsh your egg records.

TUBERCLE ON THE FACE.
 Tubercle on the face and tubercle on the feet and legs, so they have not definitely decided that the plague affecting people and domestic fowls is the same.
 It is best to be cautious, so we give you these drawings and a list of symptoms from a diseased chicken that you may not buy, eat, sell nor have birds with such a contagious deadly disease. All poultry is affected alike.
 There is no cough or spitting of blood. Fowl's comb becomes pitted; it loses appetite, spirit and weight.
 There is persistent diarrhea, progressive emaciation, and at last the bird is "skin and bone" and "light as a feather."
 Some call this disease in chickens and pigeons "going light."
 Small grayish elevations appear about mouth, eyes, nostrils and on head.
 These often form patches and range in size from a mere speck to a walnut.

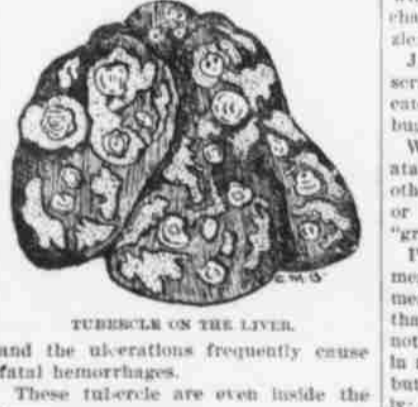


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TUBERCLE ON THE FOOT.
 They are hard and horny or soft and cheesy and full of bacilli.
 The fowl often goes lame, and an examination shows tubercle on the foot and leg.
 These may be found on all the joints, with swellings, deformities and ugly ulcers full of pus and germs. On dissection you discover tubercle in the lungs, spleen, heart, the lining of the lungs and abdominal cavity, and the intestines may be so thickened and full as to be almost closed.
 Intestinal ulcers are special germ bred, etc.
 The liver is often enlarged, soft,

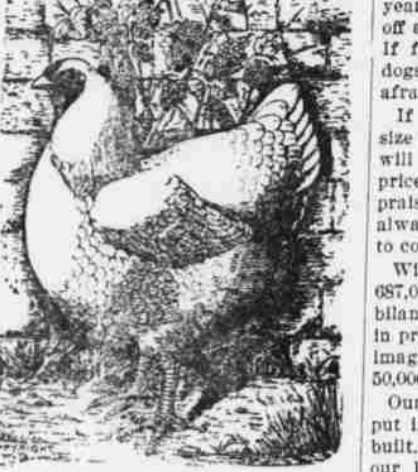


TUBERCLE ON THE LIVER.
 and the ulcerations frequently cause fatal hemorrhages.
 These tubercle are even inside the bones.
 Kill diseased birds at once. In their graves throw a shovel of lime on them and bury them deep.
 Remove well birds to new quarters and observe closely, as disease is treacherous, and it is often necessary to scotch the whole flock. Disinfect thoroughly. Conditions favorable to other diseases are conducive to tuberculosis. Therefore practice prevention; keep sanitary; keep down vermin; keep clean, take special care of molting fowls and quarantine all new stock.
HOW TO SELECT THE LAYERS.

 But it is said the Asiatics only av-



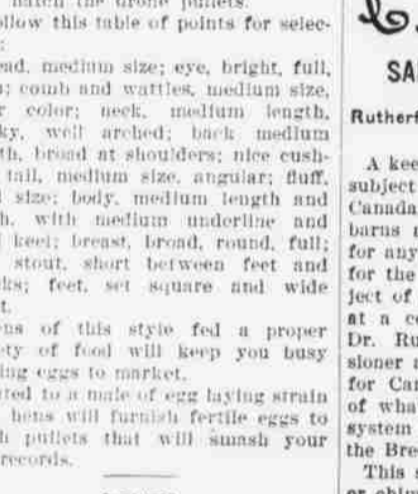
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FEATHERS AND EGGSHELLS.

Sanitation of Barns.
 Rutherford System of Providing Pure Air For Live Stock.
