COMING HOMESEEKERS.

More people will visit the Pacific Northwest this year than in any previous five-year period, says James A. Wood, Director of Exploitation of the Alaska-Yukon-Pacific Exposition.

The statement of Mr. Wood is but one of a thousand well founded predictions, all pointing to the opening of a period in which the entire Northwest is to receive one of the greatest increases in its permanent population that has occurred since the early emigration days.

The immense number of colonists who have already come and who are still to come will be distributed throughout the whole Northwestern territory and to the communities that offer the greatest inducement for settlement, will fall the lion's share of this new and desirable citizenship.

In view of that fact, it behooves the people of Polk county and its cities to make concerted and effective effort to bring before the attention of these newcomers and of prospective newcomers, the merits of this locality as a place for a homeseeker.

ROAD BUILDING PROGRESSES

Improvement Work on Bridges and Highways Being Carried on in Every District.

The season of road work in Polk county is well under way and extensive improvements have been planned and are already being carried out in every precinct in the county.

The most extensive and also the most important (by reason of the fact that it will be more permanent than ordinary gravel) is the construction of macadam work which is being carried on under contract by Wolf Brothers & Bradley, of Washington county.

The first strip of macadam finished this season was about 500 yards near Bridgeport. The crushing plant is now at the Lyons quarry near Salt Creek and macadam is being laid on the Salt Creek-Dallas road near the Dolph farmhouse.
