It is supposed that he had laid it down, with the muzzle up, against the chair and afterward, in trying to draw it toward him, had discharged it. The gun was found resting against the chair in that position later, when the other two boys returned.

They noticed upon returning that Harold was sitting motionless in his chair with his head bent forward, but supposed him to be asleep. Finally, approaching him, they ascertained that he was dead, and at once raised the alarm.

A doctor was summoned immediately. In view of the fact that the boy had been ill for so long a time, and as no mark was visible in the hasty examination that was made, it was at first supposed that death was due to heart failure. Later, when the undertaker was examining the body, he discovered the wound where the bullet had entered the abdominal cavity, and the truth about the lad's death became plain.

The mother was in Shaniko, Oregon, at the time, but a message was sent her at once and she hastened to Dallas, arriving here Wednesday night. His father is in Canada and no word of the tragedy could be sent to him at that time.

The funeral will be held this afternoon from Chapman's chapel, and the body will be interred in the Odd Fellows' cemetery.

**LAWYERS NOMINATE**  
Meet in Portland and Name Candidates for Supreme Bench.

Lawyers from all parts of Oregon, more of them from without the city than within, assembled in Department No. 1 at the Courthouse Tuesday afternoon and placed in nomination for election to the Supreme bench of the state next November the justices who will go out of office at that time: Judge Frank A. Moore, for six years; Thomas A. McBride, for four years, to fill the unexpired term of Judge Bean; Judge Will R. King, for six years under the act of 1909, and Judge W. H. Slater for four years, under the act of 1909.

The record made by the secretary, W. J. Sinnott, showed 175 attorneys present. A. C. Woodcock acted as chairman. The nominations and a speech by ex-Governor Folk, of Missouri.

There was difference of opinion as to whether the words "nonpartisan," "nonpolitical" or "independent" should go on the ballot after the names of the candidates, but upon motion of Judge M. L. Pipes it was voted to use the phrase, "Non Political Judiciary."
