WRONG IN PRINCIPLE.

Lost the published account of the proceedings of the Dallas city council on last Monday night may be misunderstood, it should be said that the ordinance placing a license on meat peddlers does not apply to farmers who slaughter their own animals for the purpose of peddling the same.

While the ordinance, in the form passed by the council, is not as detrimental to the best interest of Dallas as it would have been had the farmers been required to pay a license, the Observer believes the measure will not meet with public approval. It is evident that the ordinance contains provisions which were not acceptable to all of the members of the board, as Councilmen Kirkpatrick and Ayres cast their votes against it.

Without any desire to find fault with the council, this newspaper believes that if a license is placed on the selling of meat, a general protective license should be placed on the business of all merchants who deal in provisions and foodstuffs—and it is safe to say that such a law would meet with widespread disfavor. Since this license virtually amounts to protection for the meat markets of the city, it does not seem right that this one class of dealers alone should be singled out for such protection when many other business firms which are forced to compete with outside concerns are afforded no protection against out-of-town competition.

What protection, for instance, is given to the printers of Dallas? Is the city two printing offices with large amounts of money invested in equipment. These concerns contribute to the local taxes and pay out thousands of dollars annually for wages, every dollar of which is spent with the home merchants. Notwithstanding this fact, there is scarcely a week in the year but some salesman for a Portland or San Francisco concern visits the city for the purpose of soliciting orders for printing and to take out of Dallas and Polk County money which, if orders were given them, might never find its way back to the coffers of the home business men.

Every resident of Dallas knows this is a fact, and yet no one ever hears of any steps being taken to protect the local printers against these outside "peddlers" of printed matter. The truth is, the home printers do not ask for any such protection at the hands of the city. The local printing concerns turn out practically every dollar's worth of printing used in Dallas, and they have their work done as good or better work, at as low or lower prices, as can be obtained from the outside concerns. They win and hold their business on merit alone, and they are never heard asking the city council to take them under its protecting wing.

While the council doubtless acted conscientiously and for what it considered the best in granting this special favor to the local meat markets, the Observer believes that the ordinance is wrong in principle, smacking as it is loudly does of class legislation. However, the city fathers might have done worse. It must be said to their credit that they did not legislate against the farmers.

STRAIGHT NORMAL TALK. Before long the state's pamphlet, giving lists of initiative measures for the coming election, will be in the hands of every voter in the state. The time for consideration of the various questions that will be presented will not be any too long. Some of the bills that can be decided on now and thus be settled before the "rush" comes, should be looked over at the earliest date.

One of the measures that this paper has mentioned before is the question of re-establishing a state normal school in its locality. As to the necessity of a normal training school for teachers, there is scarcely any opposition. Occasionally we meet with some one who has not fully considered the importance of skilled teachers who will oppose the normal entirely. Then there are others who seem to think that the training given to the normal student does not fit them any better for educational work than any other that given by any other class of schools, or by the mere school of experience.

It will be admitted that some people who have had the opportunity of securing a normal training, and the suggestions that go with it, are failures as teachers. That is undoubtedly true. But is the same not true in all lines of schools and efforts in special preparation? Even the carpenter trade is not without its failures, though the terms of an apprentice may have been fully served. The individual counts. Some persons will turn out a better piece of carpentry, self instructed, than others who have had all sorts of experience and assistance. But we consider that the percent of success is higher for those carpenters who have served an apprenticeship or who have had special instruction. We do not believe that every one can be a good teacher, but we believe that the percent of teachers who understand the work, and who succeed is higher among those who have had the normal course than among those who have not had such advantages.

The course of a training taken in a good normal school gives breadth to the teacher's view. All this counts for experience and a larger percent of practical experience will be obtained in a couple of years' work in such an institution than in many years of independent labor. It is the same old story. The man of the technical school discharges an old employee, gets better wages, produces more in a given time, and does it better.

Now it is up to the people of Oregon to decide whether they want teachers who have some training, some conception of their work, a proper understanding of the purpose of education, and above all, some realization of the responsibilities they undertake—to direct the training of their children,—or will they leave it to mere hirelings and experimenters.

We want a normal in this state. We want a good one. We want it as soon and as economically as it can be secured, and we want it equipped with the best instructors in the country, and the best modern educational assistance in the way of apparatus that an economical expenditure of money will secure. We want it located convenient to the center of population, at a point that is convenient, healthful, and harmonious with the limitations that usually attend that of students.—Gresham Herald.

RECOMMENDED. In many counties of Oregon reports are that the assembly has come to be accepted as a correct rule of action for Republicans. In some counties no candidates have appeared against the assembly candidates, and in other counties the opposition is scattering and obviously weak. The opposition has its inspiration solely, in such counties, in the ambitions of individuals who have been disappointed through failure to get assembly recommendations or through knowledge that the assembly would not recommend them. Where the assembly has been representative, as it should have been, there is satisfaction with its work; where there has been a great multitude of conflicting interests, as in Multnomah, there is discontent.

But the assembly has nowhere sought to "nominate" candidates as nominations have heretofore been made by conventions. These candidates are merely "recommended." Under the primary law the assembly cannot do otherwise. It is not desired or intended to do anything else. Should the fact that any candidate has been recommended for nomination by a large number of Republicans, acting in concert, not be to his advantage?

The primary and the primary alone will decide. The whole question of Republican candidates is now before it for its judgment.—Oregonian.

AUTOMOBILE CANDIDATES. Hofer and Abraham, two of the three anti-assembly candidates for governor on the Republican ticket, are making whirlpool automobile campaigns over the state. They are probably running faster now than they will in the primaries. But some of these out-and-out politicians don't mind the expense of an automobile campaign. A plain, common plug of a self-made man like Jay Bowerman can't afford such extravagance in the race for gubernatorial honors.—Eugene Register.
