dictated by the fact that they were issued by Brigadier-General Marion P. Maus, of the United States army, who was in command of the maneuver camp, and the further fact that full details of the case have been forwarded to the War department at Washington.

Had "Hiked" Too Much

The mutiny came, it is stated, when the Second battalion arrived at Gate, Wash., from Oakville, five miles away. The troops had made the hike in heavy marching order and when they were ordered to return, there was instant rebellion. The officers held a consultation and refused to obey the command unless the men were to be permitted to return without their blankets and haversacks. This was not agreed to and the First and Third battalions promptly moved off but, for the time being, the Second stood fast. Finally stripping off their blanket rolls and haversacks they too joined in the march and returned to Oakville.

Following the arrival there of the regiment, an investigation, at the instance of Brig. Gen. Maus, was instituted, and it was found that the officers were roundly lectured by the commanding general in the presence of their companies. It is said that the General told the officers that obedience to orders is the fundamental principle of soldiering and that officers guilty of such conduct as theirs were unfit to serve in the organized militia.

Impertinence Alleged

The offending officers, aside from Captain Tooze, Jr., are Maj. Scott, Capt. Williams and First Lieutenant Richard Delch. It is charged that extreme impertinence was shown General Maus by Lieutenant Delch when reprimanded by the general for his stand, and that Captain Williams also was charged with unsoldierly replies to questions by the general. Aside from Captain Tooze, the three other offending officers live in Portland.
