Dallas to Be Host to Boys From Every Part of Oregon

Convention to be Under Auspices of Y. M. C. A.—Big Portland Delegation is Expected—Prominent Speakers to Attend Entire Two Days Session.

Preparation for the boys convention to be held in this city, November 28 to 30 at which time delegates from boys' clubs and Sunday school classes from every part of the state will gather in Dallas, is going steadily on and indications now point to one of the most successful gatherings of the clubs in the history of the organization. During the past week the various committees have accomplished wonders in preparing for the three days' meeting, and it is certain that the boys will be given a royal good time.

Most of the discussion at the conference will be carried on by the boys themselves. Leaders of the different clubs will present the problems of their work and open discussion of the questions will follow. J. W. Palmer, boys' secretary of the Portland association, will preside at most of the sessions. Among the men who will speak are L. B. Rhodes, Dr. Norman, F. Coleman and C. A. Phillips of Portland, and Rev. C. C. Curtis of Dallas.
