Proceedings Of Commissioners' Court.

The April term of County Commissioners' Court was a very busy one. In addition to the usual run of bills to be audited, and routine matters that required attention, the court appropriated the sum of \$3750 as the county's share toward the construction of the \$15,000 armory to be built in Dallas, and considered bids and made the purchase of a new rock crusher and also a road roller. The following is a detailed report of the proceedings.

ROCK CRUSHER BOUGHT
Reirson Machinery Company, of Portland, "Climax" crusher, 10x20 James 32-foot elevator, manganese dies, \$2160; no bid on gasoline roller.

Beall & Company, of Portland, "Aurora" No. 2 crusher, manganese dies, 32-foot elevator, trucks, \$1750 complete; gasoline roller, \$2750.

The bid of Beall & Company being the lowest, and the price reasonable, the contract was awarded to them to furnish both crusher and roller.

In the matter of the petition of W. L. Tooze, Jr., et al., for an apportionment for an armory at Dallas, for Polk County—it is ordered that an appropriation of \$3750 be appointed for an armory to be located at Dallas, on condition that the County of Polk shall have the free use of such armory for public meetings and fairs for the exhibition of the products of said county.
