**O. F. W. C. in Favor of Southern Oregon State Normal**

Oswego, Or., Oct. 19, 1914. To the Club Women of Oregon:

A resolution was introduced at our state convention held at Hood

River last year, endorsing the effort to reopen the Normal School at Ashland. Feeling that this was a matter of importance, it was referred to the Educational Committee for thorough investigation and a report. Such investigation was made with the result that our committee reported to the convention just held at Eugene, earnestly urging a support of this measure in the belief that its success would contribute materially to helping an urgent educational need of the state.

The convention adopted the following resolution:

"RESOLVED: That the Oregon Federation of Women's Clubs not only endorse the measure providing for the reopening of the Southern Oregon State Normal School, but pledge ourselves

to work for the same in our respective communities."

We are taking this means of informing you of the action of the Federation and requesting you, in fulfillment of that promise, to aid in furthering this measure in the hope that our work may contribute to the educational uplift of the state.
