James L. Collins, one of the early settlers of Oregon, died at his home in Dallas on Wednesday of last week. He was 83 years of age and was born in Missouri of Virginia and Kentucky stock. His great grandfather was a soldier under Washington. In 1846 with his parents he made the overland trip to Oregon, coming in by the southern route from Laramie. He was appointed county judge by Gov. Wood in 1869.
