NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS STREET PAVING

Monmouth, Oregon, April 10th, 1917. Sealed bids will be received at the office of the city recorder of Monmouth, Oregon until 6 o'clock in the afternoon of May 1, 1917, for the furnishing of all materials and labor and construction of hard surface street paving, consisting of grading streets to sub-grade, building concrete curb lines thereon, constructing hard surface paving, all according to the plans and specifications thereof prepared by the Himes Engineering Co. of Dallas, Oregon, now on file in the recorder's office of Monmouth, Oregon, which plans and specifications are hereby referred to and made a part of this notice as to the general character and nature of said proposed work, and may be seen and examined at the office of said recorder or in the office of the Himes engineering Co. at Dallas, Oregon. Each bidder is required to state in his bid the price per cubic foot for said grading, per square foot for said paving and per lineal foot for said curb lines, and the total cost thereof, and bids may be submitted for separate parts of said work, viz: one for grading, one for paving; and one for curb lines, or one bid may include all of said proposed work.

That all bids must be accompanied with a certified check of 10 per cent of the total amount of such bid, subject to forfeiture if such bid is accepted and bidder fails to enter into a contract and give bonds for the faithful performance of said work according to terms of such bid and said plans and specifications.

That such bids will be opened and examined by the Common Council of said city of Monmouth on the 1st day of May, 1917, at 8, p. m. thereof, at the Council chambers in said city, and at the said time and place either accepted or rejected, or at such time as the common council may adjourn its said meeting. Said common council reserves the right to reject any or all bids.
