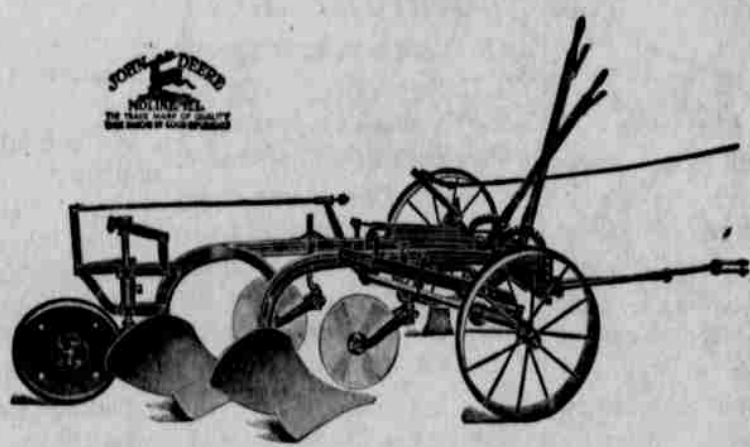


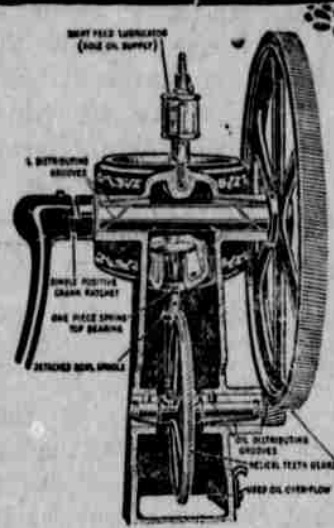

NOTICE OF STREET ASSESSMENT

Notice is hereby given that the common council of the city of Monmouth, Oregon, did, on the 11th day of August, 1916, by Resolution No. 206, entitled—

"A Resolution assessing each lot or parcel of ground with its proportionate share of the cost of improving Main street from the East line of Broad street West to the West line of Monmouth Avenue in the city of Monmouth, Oregon, by grading the same to subgrade, paving a 40 foot roadway thereon and along the center line of Main street with a concrete base 5 inches thick and an asphaltic top wearing surface 2 inches thick, and building concrete curb lines thereon, and directing the city recorder of said city of Monmouth, Oregon, to enter a statement thereof in the docket of city liens as by section 26 of the Charter of said city provided;"

—adopted on said day, assess each lot or parcel of ground, with its proportionate share of the cost of said grading, paving and construction of curbs, and that thereupon the recorder of said city duly entered a statement thereof in the docket of city liens.
