



"Rochette's Bonnie" Stump's Jersey which has Broken Butter Record

MORE RECORDS TAKEN

World Leading Jerseys at Fair Acres, Pass New Marks

They are still breaking records up at Fair Acres Stock Farm, owned by John B. Stump and Sons, and because these facts are of local interest as well as for the world of dairymen at large, we take these extracts from the coming issue of "Current Events at Fair Acres" to be printed in the Herald office this week.

Rochette's Bonnie

When Rochette's Bonnie completed her Register of Merit record of 17,382.1 lbs of milk, containing 943.12 pounds of fat, she became the highest yearly record cow that has been imported from the Island of Jersey to America. Her record exceeds that of the former holder of this honor by some ten pounds of fat. This record was previously held by none other than her own half sister, Rochette's Princess, who made a record of 933.33 lbs of fat

on yearly test; she being owned and tested by Mr. Meldrum Gray of Roswell, New Mexico. Rochette's Bonnie became, therefore, the second daughter of her sire, Rochette's Noble to produce over 900 lbs of fat in one year thereby gaining him the distinction of being the only sire in the world with the exception of Golden Glow's Chief to sire two daughters to produce over 900 lbs of fat in one year.

Rochette's Bonnie began her test May 15, 1918 at the age of 8 years and two months. On her first day in milk she produced some 32 lbs. of milk, but rose rapidly and by June 1st had passed the 60 lb. mark, reaching her maximum flow on July 1st on which day she yielded 68.6 lbs of milk. Her total flow for June was 1948.6 lbs. or almost exactly 65 pounds of milk per day for 30 days. For July she produced 1923.4 pounds of milk and 100.02 pounds

of fat. Rochette's Bonnie's first daughter in milk is now on Register of Merit test begun at 2 years, 1 month old and has milked as high as 36 pounds of milk in one day. This heifer is an exceptionally fine show cow as well a producer.

Another World's Record

Great as is the record of Rochette's Bonnie, she is by no means the only great cow in the Fair Acres herd.

Diamond of Fair Acres, a heifer bred on the farm has recently completed a record that makes her the World's Champion Junior three year old Jersey for Milk Production and 2nd in the class for fat. Her production of 17,373 lbs. of milk exceeds by more than one ton the former highest yield for her age and is the 10th highest yield ever made by any Jersey cow of any age. Her yield of 831.79 pounds of fat is the second highest yield in the Junior three year old class and is exceeded only by that of Vive La France who also holds the senior Four year old and World's record, all ages, for the Jersey breed.

The best daily yield credited to Diamond was made on August 8th on which date she produced 62.8 pounds of milk, being then in milk 110 days. Diamond of Fair Acres was sired by the imported bull Diamond's Tinel Draconis who was of Raleigh Financial King, breeding, having been sired by Draconies of St. Saviors, who was by Mabel's Raleigh, and out of Draconis 7th, who was said to be one of the three best daughters of Financial King. Diamond's Lord Draconis, also sired Moyane of Fair Acres with a record of 471 pounds of fat as a 3 year old and has a large number of other good daughters. Now owned by Connell Bros. of Shedd, Oregon.
