A Few Flu Cautions

A year ago influenza was epidemic

in Polk county, beginning its deadly work. Everybody should know how to escape the disease to protect themselves and to avoid spreading it when they have been exposed. The disease is contagious and spreads very rapidly. Avoid everything that brings on a cold. Sleep warm and see that bedding and room are not damp—fresh air, but no draft. Do not go to bed in a heated room that cools down to chilly later in the night, for that will chill your body while you rest and invite influenza.

The greatest danger of exposure and when the disease finds the most victims is when there is east or north winds. Be sure to clothe yourself in warm garments and sleep warm.

Keep away from public gatherings, for there are always careless people who go out and into crowds with colds and spread disease. Avoid them by staying at home when there is influenza in the community.

When you have a cold or feel indisposed, stay at home, consult a doctor and follow his advice.

Let everybody act with good judgment and not get frightened or go into a panic and put blame and condemnation on everybody, but see to it that they themselves help to prevent the spread of influenza. Cleanliness in person and habits, regular hours for rest and sleep, and plain diet should be the rule of living to keep the body in good health and vigor.

Let everyone help save life and sickness by careful compliance with the rules and advice given in these lines. Almost all who lost their lives from influenza or suffered severe sickness, did so directly or indirectly from unnecessary exposure.
