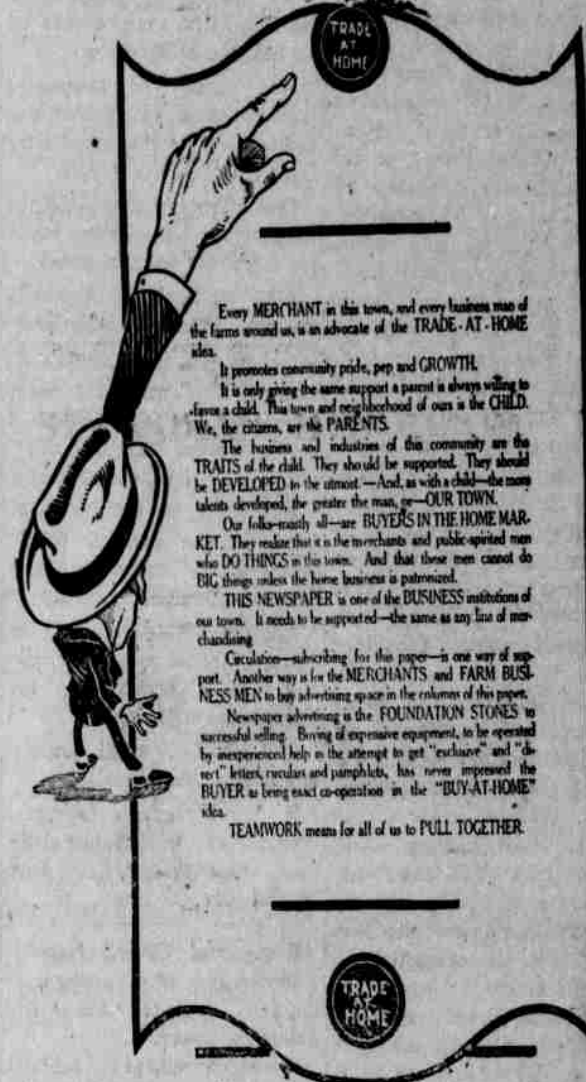
### HENRY GAINES HAWN
