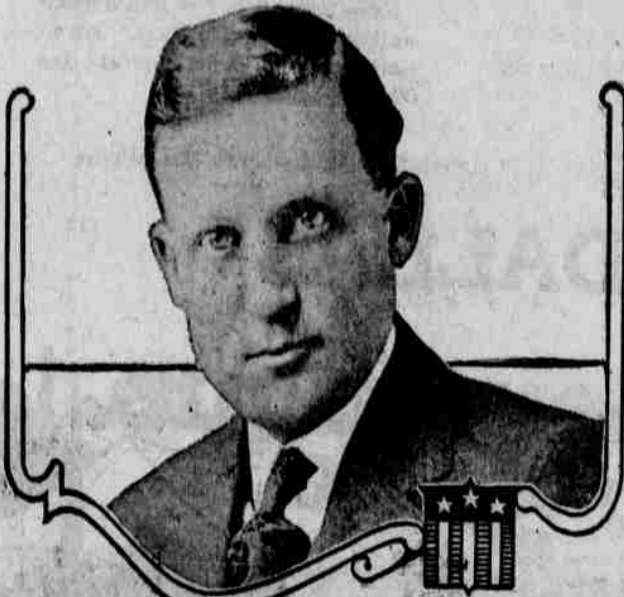
Julius Caesar Nayphe Opens Chautauqua With Unique Entertainment Feature

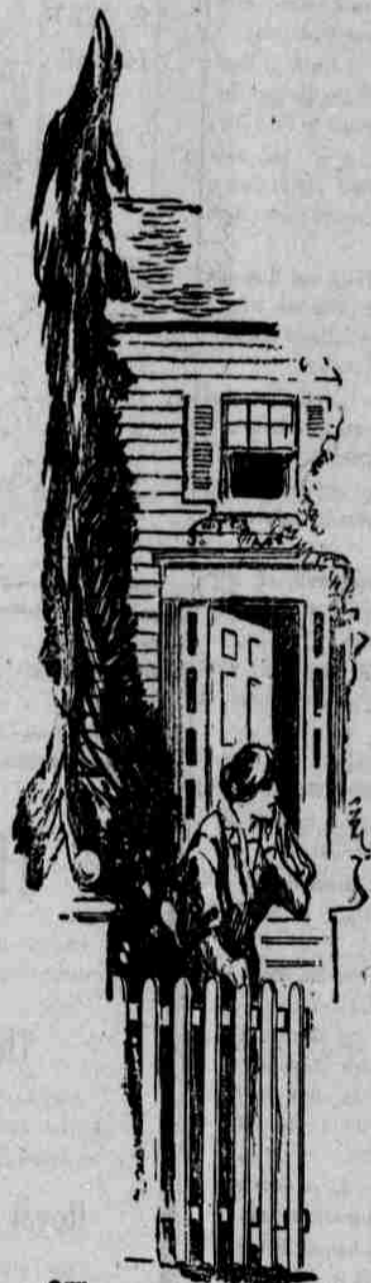
