Handsaker on his return from a summer in relief work in Armenia. "They declare they will not leave until every child in Armenia is cared for. Last year for a time we were obliged to put our orphans on half and quarter rations, and thousands of our children died. When I was in Armenia last summer the children were in rags, some had practically nothing on, others wore grain sacks or flour sacks. Then it was warm, but as Mount Ararat towers above the country, I realized that before long those rags will be of no use, and they must have warm clothing."
