



THE CALIFORNIA BUILDING AT A-Y-P. EXPOSITION, SEATTLE.

California's handsome building is one of the very striking structures on the grounds of the Alaska-Yukon-Pacific Exposition. It is in the old Spanish Mission type of architecture encountered so frequently in Southern California, and the detail of its front has attracted the attention of artists and architects from all over the country.

In the building every county of the golden state will have an exhibit. California, from Siskiyou to San Diego, has shown as much enthusiasm for the Exposition as has Washington itself.

Yukon Avenue is one of the many ways leading to the Court of Honor of the Alaska-Yukon-Pacific Exposition. It leads from the Cascades down to one of the many entrances to the Pay Streak and directly to the "caf  center" of the Fair Grounds.

On the left of the picture a facade of the European Exhibits Building shows. On the right is a corner of the Palace of Agriculture. In the distance, and across the Cascades, is to be seen the Oriental Building.

All of these structures were completed before December 1, 1908. They are of the conventional exposition type of construction—plaster staff over heavy wooden framework.
