

HEART FAILURE CAUSES DEATH

Last Saturday Mrs. Hester A. Herron was found lying dead in her home at Monmouth by her son, where she had evidently died suddenly from heart failure. She was sitting or reclining, with her open bible in her lap, in which she had no doubt just been reading some of the precious promises of her Saviour, when death opened the door to the mysterious beyond and she was permitted to go to meet her Lord.

Mrs. Herron was born in Missouri on the eleventh day of January, 1835. She was married to James Herron in 1852, while crossing the plains. They came to Oregon where they resided up to the time of their death with the exception of six years which they spent in California. Her husband died six years ago. She was the mother of nine children, six of whom are living: William, Charles, George, Robert, Mrs. Mariah Simpson and Mrs. Lizzie Fuller. She has one brother living, namely, Richard Rodgers.

Twenty years ago she united with the Baptist church and lived a devoted christian life. The cause of her death was from heart failure.

The funeral service was held Sunday at 2 o'clock from the Baptist church of Monmouth and was conducted by Rev. Maynard R. Thompson. A large company of sympathetic friends were present. The remains were laid away in the cemetery south-west of Dallas.
