The following were placed on the roll of honor for the county for having no tardies during the month: Smithfield, Red Prairie, Scroggins, No. 15, Airlie, Bethel, Fairview, Oak Point, Elkins, Antioch, Harmony, Upper Salt Creek, Lincoln, Saver, Etna, McTimmonds Valley, Greenwood, Sunny Slope, Concord, Oakdale, Black Rock, Pioneer, Highland.

The attendance this last month has been good and it is hoped that all parents, teachers and children will do their best to see that it remains as good during the entire year, as teachers and children cannot do their best work when the attendance is not the best possible.

Four hundred and thirty-one tardies are too many for this county. It ought to be reduced considerably and it is requested that all will aid the teachers in keeping the tardies down.

At the beginning of the school year County Superintendent Seymour sent a circular letter to all teachers asking that among other things done this year, that grounds be cleaned and that each child or at least each family have its individual drinking cup.

Now over half of the schools in the county have reported the grounds cleaned, out-buildings repaired, and about two-thirds have reported the individual drinking cups.

These are all being asked for because of the benefit to the health of the children and if all parents, school officers and teachers would work together in these matters we would soon have the blue ribbon county in the state for health conditions of the children.

Conflict in Election Laws.

A change in the laws made by the brilliant session of 1909 uncovers another conflict which will show that session a little higher in the Hall of Fame, says Salem Statesman.

This time it is in the election laws.

An act was passed changing the time of the general election from June to November. This act provides that other laws relating to election and registration be governed accordingly and consequently the time for registration is shoved ahead until June. Registration prior to this time has started with January of the year of the election.

In another act the legislature provided that the county court in each county shall meet in July and at such meeting shall pass on the precinct boundaries and other matters pertaining to the election in such county. Under this provision the precinct boundaries would be established fully a month after registration started and endless confusion would be the consequence as people would not be aware as to where they should register and many registrations might be made in the wrong precincts.
