NEWS OF OREGON

\$5668 Fines Are Collected.

During the year of 1909 there were 199 arrests made by the wardens throughout the state, and a total of \$5668 in fines collected, as against eighty-nine arrests and \$2815 in fines for the preceding year, which makes a good showing for the warden and his deputies.

Roselair to Hang February 11.

John Roselair, the wife murderer of Washington county, is to be hanged for his crime February 11. He is now confined in the death cell at the state penitentiary.

Oregon's Share.

Out of receipts from sales of public lands in Oregon last year \$888,043 goes to the credit of the state in the reclamation fund, and \$41,144 is paid to the state for its schools. Washington state gets \$446,800 to its credit in the reclamation fund and \$19,303 for its schools.

Prize Certificates Received.

Certificates for grand prizes awarded to the state of Oregon for its general educational display, for its hops, wool and complete display of woods at the Alaska-Pacific-Yukon exposition have been received by Governor Benson. A certificate of honorable mention for the flax display from this state was also received.

Respected Pioneer Is Dead.

Edward Hirsch, former state treasurer and early pioneer of the state, died at Salem last week from heart failure. He came to Oregon in the year 1858 and conducted a mercantile store at Dallas until 1861 when he went to Silverton where with his brother, Sol Hirsch, he conducted a mercantile establishment for another three years, when Edward went to Salem. Except two years spent at Brownsville in 1866-7 he had been a resident of Salem continuously ever since. He was state treasurer during 1878 to 1887. He held many offices of trust during his lifetime and was widely known throughout the west.

Was Janitor 25 Years.

Joseph Albrich, for twenty-five years janitor at the state capitol, died last week at his home at 1080 Court street, Salem, after a short illness. Mrs. Theo. Barr and Mrs. M. J. Petzel are daughters of the deceased. Mr. Albrich was eighty-two years old, and was a native of the Austrian Tyrol. His wife passed away last winter. His funeral took place last Friday from the Catholic church.
