OBSERVANCE OF EASTER SUNDAY

Next Sunday will be Easter. In all Christendom, it will be observed as a festival in commemoration of the resurrection of Christ. "It originated in the circumstance that Christ was typified by the paschal lamb ordained by Moses to be slain at the feast of the Passover; the feast being considered as a continuation, in the fulfillment, of the Jewish festival. The English name, 'Easter', and the German name, 'Ostern', are derived from the name of the Teutons' goddess, Ostera (Anglo-Saxon, Eostre), whose festival was celebrated by the ancient Saxons with peculiar solemnities, in the month of April, and for which as in many other instances, the first Roman Catholic missionaries substitute the paschal feast.

"Easter was observed as a most joyous day; catechumens—those ready for entrance into the church—were dressed in white and solemnly baptized." In connection with this service the Lord's Supper and alms were liberally distributed to the poor.

In the early church there was much controversy as to when Easter should be kept. The eastern church persisted in keeping it on the same day with the Jewish passover. The western church celebrated it on Sunday as the day of Christ's resurrection. The council of Nice settled the dispute in 325 A. D. It ordained that Easter should always and everywhere be kept on the Sunday next after the full moon that comes on or first after the vernal equinox, (which falls on March 21) provided that when the full moon was on Sunday, Easter should come the Sunday following. This made it so it never could be coincident with the Passover. According to this rule, Easter may occur as early as March 22 and no later than April 25. With the exception of a few churches all Christianity is governed by this rule.

Grain prospects in the Willamette valley are little less satisfactory. Because of the unusually heavy snowfall in the mountains during the past winter, there will be plenty of water for irrigation purposes this year.
