Notice is hereby given that at a regular meeting of the Common Council of the City of Independence, Oregon, to be held in the Council Chamber of said City on the 4th day of May, 1910, at the hour of 7:30 o'clock p. m., the said City will sell 50 negotiable coupon bonds of said

City, of the principal amount of \$20,000.00 in the aggregate, as authorized by Ordinance No. 107 of said City, entitled "A bill to propose by initiative petition an ordinance authorizing the issuance and sale of bonds of the City of Independence, Oregon, for the purpose of raising funds for the construction of a system of sewers in said City", proposed by initiative petition filed with the City Recorder on the 19th day of January, 1910, ordained by the City Council on the 19th day of January, 1910, referred to the people and approved by a majority of the votes cast thereon at a special election held in said City on the 28th day of March, 1910, and by proclamation of the Mayor dated April 6, 1910, declared to be in full force and effect as the ordinance of said City. said bonds are in denominations of \$2.00 each, payable twenty years from the first day of May, 1910, (with the privilege, optional with said City, of paying said bonds or any thereof at any time after the first day of May, 1910,) and bear interest at the rate of five per cent per annum, payable semi-annually, from May 1, 1910, until paid; principal and interest payable at the First National Bank of Portland, Oregon, in gold coin, without costs, charge or expense to the purchaser or holder of said bonds. Said bonds will be sold to the highest bidder or bidders therefor, but will not be sold for less than their face value.

The said Council reserves the right to accept bids for any part of said issue of bonds hereby advertised to be sold, if bids for a part only of such bonds be received, and also reserves the right to reject any and all bids.
