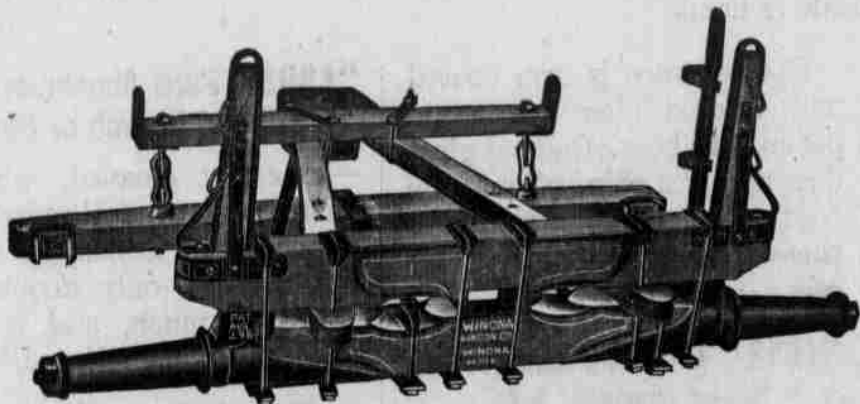

Oregon Trunk Extension
Bids have been asked for grading on the Oregon Trunk south from Mad-

ras to the north line of the Klamath Falls Indian reservation, a distance of 111 miles. It is expected to have the work started May 1 and to have the grading completed next January. The line will cross Opal Prairie, Juniper Butte, the Redmond and Rosland irrigated districts and will probably soon be extended to Klamath Falls as the indicated terminus is not a desirable one.
