Oregon leads the whole country in apple production this season, according to the latest report of the Department of Agriculture, which deals with orchard conditions up to September 1. The condition of the state's apple crop at that time was given as 93 per cent of a full crop, while its nearest competitor could show but 90 per cent. The condition of the crop throughout the whole country was given as 46.8 per cent of a full crop. Northwest states make the best showing of all.
