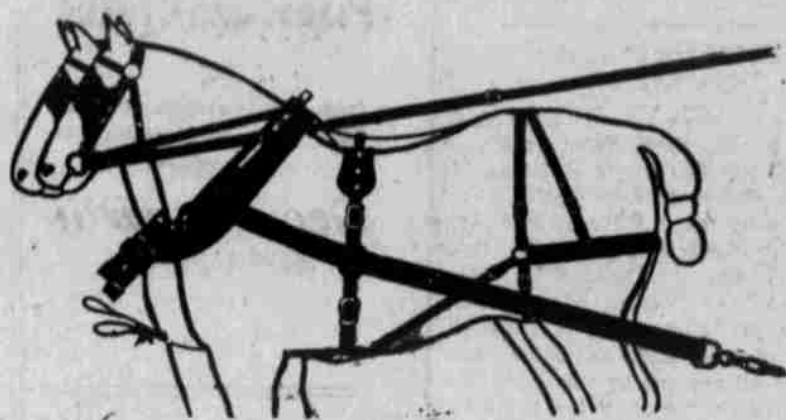


# Polk County's Leading Hardware Firm
