WILL NOT COME WEST

Chairman of the Contest Board of American Automobile Association Can't Find Time to Visit the Pacific Coast.

According to a letter that has just been received by Frank M. Fretwell, secretary of the Pacific Highway Association, from S. M. Butler, Chairman Contest Board of the American Automobile Association, the Glidden Tour will not come to the Pacific Coast for the coming year, as the route will be confined to the principal cities of the Atlantic seaboard, however, the officials of the A. A. A. are actively advocating the holding of a transcontinental and Pacific Coast tour for 1912 and the matter will be brought before the Manufacturers Contest Association committee, which meets in Chicago within a few days.

The principal reason for not coming to the Pacific Coast, as stated by the Contest Board of the National organization, is that there is not sufficient length of time to properly prepare for a transcontinental tour or a strictly Pacific Coast event, because of the fact that territory to be covered is new and is so far away from the headquarters of the controlling organization.

Undoubtedly there will be a lot of Eastern pressure brought to bear to make the 1912 contest a transcontinental affair. However the automobile clubs of the Coast will undoubtedly make a decided effort to make next year's event a strictly Pacific Coast one, covering practically the route of the Pacific Highway from Tia Juana, Mexico to Vancouver, B. C. By that time, a great deal of actual construction work on the Pacific Highway will be completed and with the knowledge that the Glidden Tour will be held over this route all the bad places would be put in first class shape, even though but temporary repairs could be made.

There is no question but what the American Automobile Association is taking wise steps in recognizing the Pacific Coast and it is believed by those who are conversant with motoring affairs that the National association should follow out the same scheme next year in coming to the Coast as they are doing this year in touring the Atlantic seaboard. The A. A. A. is also extending their contest board by appointing a member to that body from every state through which the Glidden Tour will pass, and have asked Mr. Fretwell to serve in that capacity for the state of Washington. Fretwell has again assured the officials of the National Motoring organization that he will co-operate with them in every way possible in promoting the Glidden Tour for the Pacific Coast in 1912.

FREE PUBLIC SCHOOL TEXTBOOKS

Representative Clyde has a free textbook bill that will probably become a law. The last state textbook commission paved the way for this bill by asking for too many changes. The people had no more than got used to the books they had when a sweeping change was made, and many new books added. The biggest burdens on the families of the poor in connection with education is the textbook imposition. The time has come to allow all districts that want to do so to supply free textbooks.

Clyde, of Multnomah, was a poor boy in his youth, and suffered the privation of the poor. Such a man can feel deeply on such a subject, and his bill will be pushed hard.

Many a parent's eyes have filled with tears as the child comes home with the printed slip calling for the long list of books. It is to wipe away a few of the tears from the eyes of poor people, and let them send their children to the public school without the stigma of begging books from the district that this bill is introduced.—Capital Journal.
